Paradise Park unveils Attractions for Fall Season

Admission to the Haunted Castle Maze is \$5.95 (plus tax).

The foam factory, one of the most popular attractions for all ages, will add a haunted twist to the experience all day every day in October. **Ollie's Haunted Foam Factory** opens Friday, October 2. Normal foam factory admission prices apply, which is \$5.95 (plus tax) for children and \$3 (plus tax) for adults.

"Hayrides, Haunted Castle Maze and Haunted Foam Factory are favorites in our Fall lineup," said Jon Ellis, Paradise Park president and CEO. "We are also proud to partner with local not for profits and assist such wonderful organizations with a fundraising opportunity.
